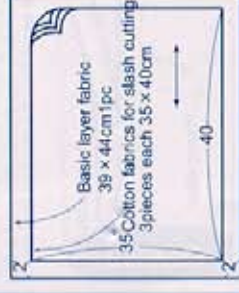
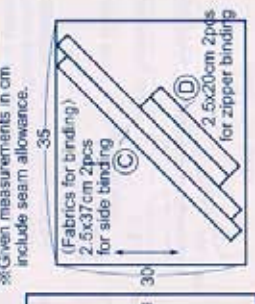
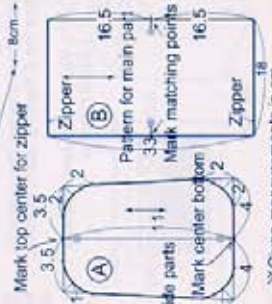
SLASH QUILT



- Materials**
- Upper layer fabrics 3 pieces size 35 x 40cm
 - Cotton fabric 1 piece size 35 x 44cm
 - Basic layer fabric 1 piece size 35 x 44cm
 - Fabric for binding 1 piece size 30 x 35cm
 - Zipper, 16cm
 - Sewing machine thread #80 (color to match top layer fabric)

Notions

- CLOVER Slash Cutter
- CLOVER Patchwork Pins
- CLOVER Water-soluble Marker
- CLOVER Patchwork scissors (mini)
- CLOVER Patchwork scissors (large)
- Sewing machine needle # 11
- Etc.



※Given measurements in cm include seam allowance.

(Fabrics for SLASH QUILT(Chenille))

A slash quilt is a soft, frayed fabric created by layering three pieces of cotton, rayon or silk fabric on a basic fabric. Because the quilting and slashing are done on the bias, the edges fluff up, resulting in a softly frayed new fabric. The end color of the chenille depends on the colors of the fabrics used, the most important one being the top layer. Softness is a result of the type of material one chooses. For example, you obtain a soft chenille effect using rayon. Using a sturdy cotton basic layer stabilizes rayon chenille. Try silk fabric for a different effect. At first, experiment with small swatches of different fabrics until the results are to your liking.

Makes Faux Chenille cutting fast and easy. Just insert the guide and push.

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SLASH QUILT(Chenille)

How to make a Slash Quilt (Chenille) Bag

1. Slash quilt

Basic layer fabric



① Pile a layer of three pieces of cotton fabric on top of the basic layer fabric with grains in the same direction. The basic layer fabric is larger than the upper fabrics for easier stitching.

CLOVER Slash Cutter
Width of guide 6~10mm



② Insert the guide of slash cutter into tunnel (use guide 6-10 mm).

③ Short tunnels should be cut with scissors.



④ Make paper pattern according to diagram A and B. The measurements include seam allowance.



⑤ After cutting, sew 0.3 cm from the edge in order to avoid fray/rag.



⑥ Baste the main and side parts, lining up matching points. Sew a 0.5 cm seam allowance with sewing machine.



⑦ Overlap 3.7 cm binding fabric on slash quilt with right sides together. Fold the end of binding fabric before sewing. Overlap at the end. Sew a 0.6 cm seam allowance.



⑧ Use several pins to hold layers in place. Mark stitching lines in a 45 degree to grain.



⑨ Mark parallel lines 0.8 cm apart for machine sewing. Back-stitch at both ends to secure.



⑩ Cut all the tunnels.

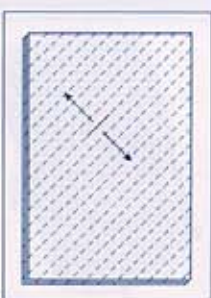


⑪ With right sides together, place 20 cm binding fabric on slash quilt.

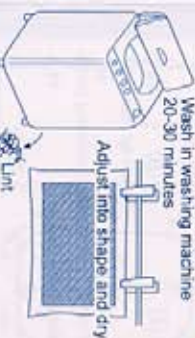
<Finished Bag>



⑫ Fold binding twice into quilt to hide seam. Stitch with slip stitch.



⑬ Wash in the washing machine without detergent for 20-30 minutes. Suggestion: use a washing net-bag.



⑭ Wash in the washing machine without detergent for 20-30 minutes. Suggestion: use a washing net-bag. Sitches should red show on the right side.



⑮ Match zipper teeth with the edge of binding and back stitch 0.5 cm.

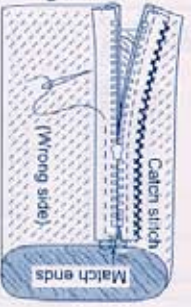
<Curved Slash Quilt>



⑯ Make 1-2 cm cuts at the start of the tunnels of the 3 upper layers carefully with scissors. Do not cut basic layer.



⑰ Usually fabrics shrink after washing. Therefore, you should plan your quilt a bit larger than the required final size.



⑱ Sew the other side accordingly. Catch stitch edges of zipper.
