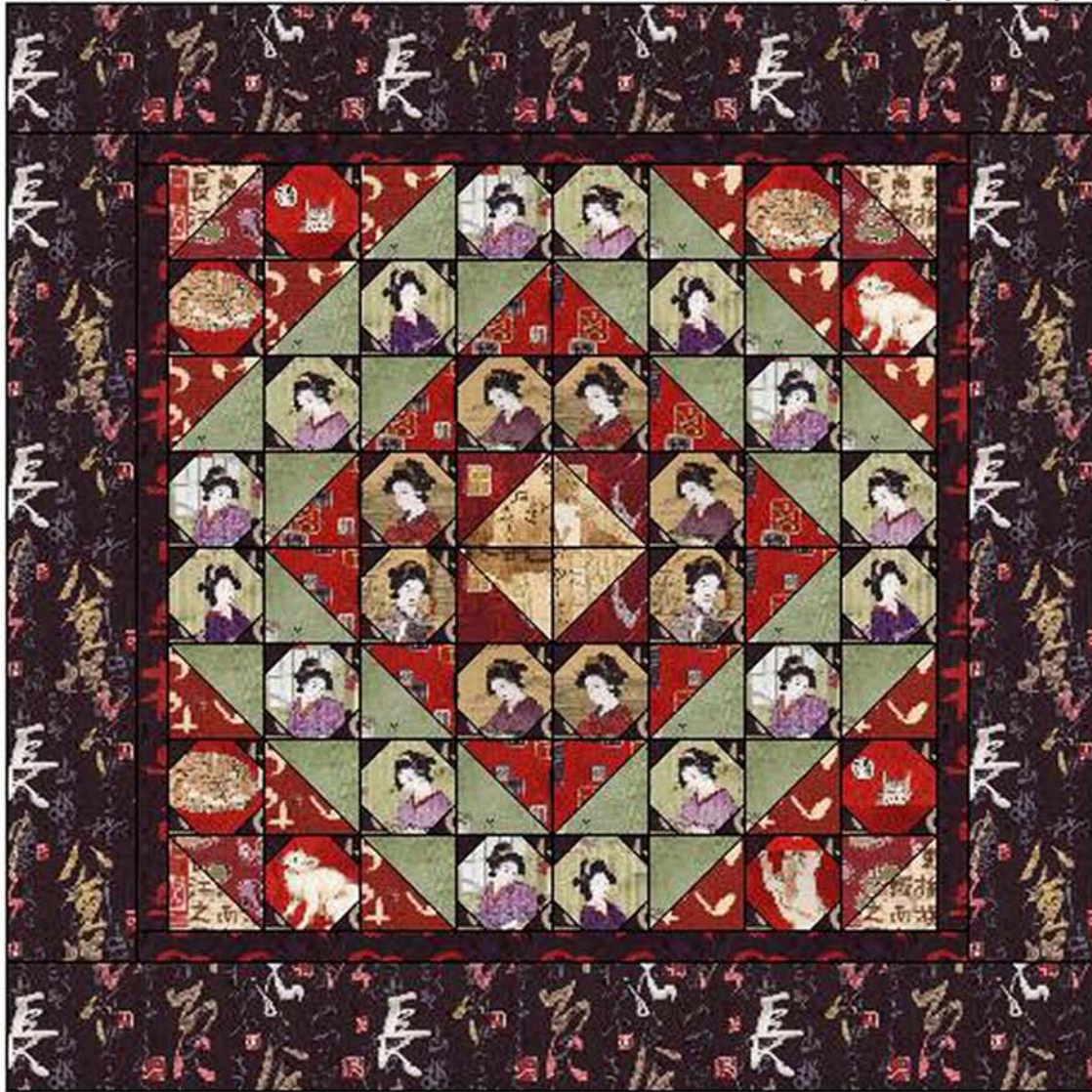

## Yardage & Cutting Requirements (based on 44" wide fabrics)

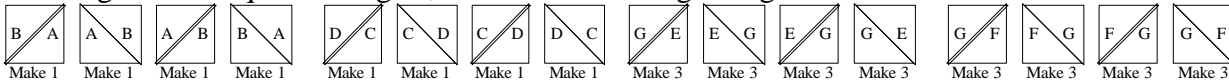
Fabric A:	1/4 yard tan documents print (5281-5 Parchment)	Cut two 5-3/8" squares
Fabric B:	1/4 yard crimson script print (5252-1 Crimson)	Cut two 5-3/8" squares
Fabric C:	1/4 yard red shoe print (5368-2 Crimson)	Cut two 5-3/8" squares
Fabric D:	1/4 yard cream with small letters (5361-3 Parchment)	Cut two 5-3/8" squares
Fabric E:	1/4 yard red with large cream letters (5254-2 Crimson)	Cut six 5-3/8" squares
Fabric F:	1/4 yard red with small documents (5251-3 Antique)	Cut six 5-3/8" squares
Fabric G:	1/2 yard pale green with cats (4961-3 Celadon)	Cut twelve 5-3/8" squares
Fabric H:	1/2 yard red with cats (4961-2 Antique)	Fussy cut eight 5" squares
Fabric I:	3/4 yard cream with geishas (5232-1 Parchment)	Fussy cut eight 5" squares
Fabric J:	1-1/4 yards pale green with geishas (5232-4 Celadon)	Fussy cut sixteen 5" squares
Fabric K:	1/2 yard black with large cream letters (5254-5 Jet)	Cut 128 2" squares
Fabric L:	1/3 yard black with large red letters (5254-6 Black)	Cut four 2" strips
Fabric M:	1-1/4 yards black with script writing (5252-3 Black)	Cut two 6-1/2 x 42" strips
	<i>parallel to selvage</i> , from remaining yardage cut four 6-1/2" x 28" strips perpendicular to selvage	
Fabric N:	1/2 yard black with small documents (5251-5 Black)	Cut six 2-1/2" x 44" strips
Fabric O:	3-1/8 yards tossed mixed motifs on cream for backing (5280-5 Parchment)	

56" x 56" quilt batting

## Sewing Instructions:

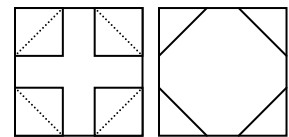
1. Cut *half* of each Fabric A, Fabric B, Fabric C, Fabric D, Fabric E, Fabric F and Fabric G 5-3/8" squares into two equal halves:  Then cut the other half of the squares  diagonally in the opposite direction:

2. Using the half square triangles, make the following triangle sets:



3. On the wrong side of each of the Fabric K 2" squares draw a diagonal line.

4. Lay a 2" Fabric K square right sides together on all corners of the 5" Fabric H, I & J squares. Stitch along the marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4" then press the triangles out to the corners.



5. Lay out all blocks as shown in Quilt Photo. Stitch blocks into rows then sew rows together.

6. Stitch a 2" Fabric L strip to right and left sides of quilt center. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions. Add remaining 2" Fabric L strips to top and bottom of quilt.

7. Sew the 6-1/2" x 42" Fabric M strips that were cut parallel to the selvage, to the right and left sides of the quilt.

8. Make each of the two remaining border strips by sewing two 6-1/2" x 28" Fabric M strips together end-to-end. Add these to the top and bottom of the quilt.

9. Cut Fabric O into two equal lengths and stitch together along selvage edge. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together. Quilt or tie as desired.

10. Prepare binding from 6 strips Fabric N, each 2-1/2" x 44".

11. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

12. Apply binding.
